1. Establish a firm foundation.

- 1. Learned that the giving starts from a state of heart and mind, somewhere much deeper than the physical. Moved and propelled by the possibilities this opens up all the time, we found many humble opportunities to serve. This has helped us to shift from the "me" point of view where we only pray for ourselves, to "others" point of view where we actively contribute to the welfare of others.
- 2. We serve to express our gratitude. We did not start this ministry because we had something to give, but the trigger came when we had nothing left to take. We acknowledged the fullness of life through faith in the goodness of God and the work God was doing in our lives. By feeling gratitude for that, we decided to pay forward our gifts with hearts filled with joy. It is this inner transformation that gave birth to the ministry.
- 3. We have learned that service to others transforms us, when we give, we actually receive. When we started this ministry, the small acts changed our deeply embedded habits of self-centredness. Service to others is never wasted because we also benefit from it.
- 4. We have learned that service to others honours our deep interconnectedness. We have learned to feel what others feel when they are low. We have learned to feel their joy and relief when their dignity has been restored through our efforts. "When you help, you see life as weak. When you fix, you see life as broken. When you serve, you see life as whole." That is the privileged position we can serve from to others.
- 5. New learning is beginning to unfold. We have now become very much aware of the current situation that others live in and that we are becoming instruments of a greater order. As a result, our actions are becoming more effortless. We are also noticing that our actions are creating a ripple effect that will synergize with other ripple effects, to create an ecosystem that will be felt by many future generations.
